

2023 Street Preservation Project

As part of the City Council’s continuing commitment to repair and preserve our infrastructure, the City recently completed repairing and slurry sealing over 5.4 miles of streets. Roads repaired include Old Redwood Highway, Commerce, Park, McGinnis, Jorgensen, Ross, Lipton, Lancaster, Dyquisto, East Sierra, Chadwick, Cervantes, Maple, Alder, Blodgett, and Trebino.



West Sierra Sewer Main Replacement Project (Sewer Enterprise Project)

Construction is anticipated to begin late October and extend into November with significant disruption to traffic during working hours. The project replaces the existing sewer in West Sierra Avenue from Olof Street to Terrace Drive (Countryside Mobile Home Park). The Contractor has 55 working days from the notice to proceed to complete the work.

Pocket Park and McGinnis/Marsh Pathway

This project recently reconstructed the pathways from McGinnis Circle to Marsh, including hardscape improvements to Pocket Park (bollard lighting, benches, and bottle filling station), smoothing and paving the dirt sections at McGinnis Circle on both sides of the Laguna bridge, and smoothing and paving the pathway from McGinnis Circle to Marsh Way.
