

Street Paving and Bike/Ped enhancement Projects: The City is working simultaneously on two major street projects: paving and enhancements to bike/ped along W Sierra Avenue and the inner hub and Myrtle area street paving. Residents and businesses alike should heed City messaging for upcoming work and use alternative routes. Preliminary work is happening now (early April) and will intensify in May. Work is expected to be substantially completed by the middle of June.

Parks: The City is very actively improving its parks consisting of major improvements to Kotate and Pocket parks and will hold workshops for planned improvements to Putnam Park and the future of the Veronda-Falletti Ranch barns. Construction is underway for Kotate and Pocket parks with volunteer opportunities to plant and mulch Pocket Park in April. 2023 will be the year for planning improvements for Putnam Park, in accordance with the Park Capital Plan, with construction to follow in 2024.

End of the Drought – for now. As everyone is well aware, this has been a very wet year and the local water supply reservoirs are at an all time high for this time of year. The City in March rescinded the water shortage conditions and is very appreciative of the residents and businesses with their efforts to reduce water use. The City exceeded the water reduction targets through these efforts and we can take a breather. The City and Sonoma Water are working on operational strategies to improve the reliability of the region’s water supply to make droughts less frequent and less drastic. Information on these efforts can be found on Sonoma Water’s website.

Veronda Falletti Ranch Programming

Together with our ranch operators, Farmster and Sandy Loam, we are conducting an online survey to gather information from community members about the types of programs they would like to see offered.
