Chapter 9.30 of the Cotati Municipal Code PROHIBITION AGAINST FIREWORKS

The use of fireworks is misdemeanor in the City of Cotati. Fireworks cause structure fires, injure people, and cause our pets to run away. Do not use fireworks. Call police dispatch at 707-792-4611 to report the use of fireworks in Cotati.

**Street Paving and Bike/Ped enhancement Project:** The City has largely completed extensive paving reconstruction on Myrtle Avenue and several nearby streets while improving the trail in front on Putnam Park and repaving the park parking lot.

**Downtown Paving Project:** Simultaneously the City is also working on paving and enhancements to bike/ped along West Sierra Avenue and the inner hub streets. Work is expected to be substantially completed by the middle of July.

**Kotate Park:** If you haven't been there, we recommend that you check out the extensive improvements to Kotate Park, in the neighborhood behind Olivers Market. In addition to new playgrounds and swing sets, there is now a gazebo and group picnic areas, a new restroom, water fountains, adult exercise equipment, lighting and extensive landscape improvements.

**More Park Improvements to Come!** The City will be hosting workshops to get feedback on potential improvements to Putnam Park and Sunflower Park later this summer, so keep an eye out!

**Other Road Work.** The City is also working on a safety project for a crosswalk on Valparaiso at Lund Hill to improve the safety of the walking connection to Delano Park. Additionally, the City is planning paving maintenance this fall and major roadwork next spring on Redwood Drive and Cypress Avenue. Lots of great work happening in a neighborhood near you!


