

West Side Street Project

Old Redwood Highway between Page and Myrtle has been completed, as well as the new walking path on West School Street. Resumption of roadway rehabilitation is awaiting warmer weather – tentatively planned to restart mid to late March.



This \$3.7M project is the next project in the City Council’s continuing large investment in the City Road system to fix our roads and reduce long term maintenance costs. The contractor will also reconstruct Condor Ct., Robin, John Roberts, West Cotati Avenue, West School Street, Clifford, and Richardson Lane.

Wayfinding Sign Program

The second phase of wayfinding informational kiosks are currently being installed along the Laguna De Santa Rosa trail, at the Cotati Train Depot and around Downtown. This work is expected to be largely complete by mid-March. The interpretive panel elements of the signs are awaiting final approval and will be installed at a later date.
