

Veronda-Falletti Ranch Construction



The City will begin renovating the farm house and rebuilding the water tower, with construction expected to begin in early March and planned to be complete by May 2020.

Work at the farm house includes removing lead paint, re-roofing the house, and replacing the heating system and electrical wiring. Additionally, the water tower will be completely rebuilt to meet current building codes, with an accessible restroom for the public and office/storage space. The improvements are intended to preserve the buildings far into the future, improve safety and accessibility, and accommodate a growing list of community workshops and activities at the farm. Immediately following construction, Farmster is planning to bring a variety of new heritage animals to the farm, such as KuneKune pigs, Shetland sheep, alpaca, chickens and others that are gentle for kids and support the planned educational programs for all ages.
