

Reverb Boutique Hotel Proposed

At the City Council meeting on November 28, 2017, the City Council approved a property sale agreement with a long-time Sonoma County family to build and operate a modern boutique hotel in Cotati. The vision for this project is to be uniquely Cotati, with the Reverb brand complimenting Cotati's deep musical heritage with an environmentally friendly design and an emphasis on local Sonoma County food, wine, drink, and entertainment. If approved, the planned project will be adjacent to US 101 and 116, and will anchor the north end of downtown Cotati.

Please visit the City website regularly for updates, as the property sale agreement is only the first step in what will be a series of public meetings to review and comment on the proposed project in 2018.

COTATI AT WORK

Year in Review

- ◇ Downtown got a splash of color in early July with new flowering plants replacing bare spots and older, less appealing vegetation. Myrtle Avenue was refreshed to fill in the original landscape strips and restore the beauty of this busy residential corridor.
- ◇ Sidewalk improvements were made at Cator Field along School Street to continue the Veronda-Falletti pathway and create continuous safe sidewalks on E. School St.
- ◇ Completed Old Redwood Highway South
 This project consisted of repaving and striping through downtown, refurbishing crosswalks and accessibility ramps. An in-roadway lighted crosswalk has been installed with this project across Old Redwood Highway at Page Street.
- ◇ Sunflower Park was improved with the resurfacing and striping of the tennis courts, adding dual striping for pickle ball.
- ◇ As part of the City-wide bike/pedestrian safety project, the City Public Works crew have installed three radar feedback signs at entry points to the City to slow drivers, Flashing Lights at Stop Signs and added crosswalk and signage on West Sierra Avenue at Cypress.
