

Compost Rebate Program - 10% Rebate

To encourage the use of compost and to help meet statewide climate action goals, Zero Waste Sonoma is offering a 10% rebate for compost purchases totaling at least 30 cubic yards in a year, up to 1,000 cubic yards. Compost greatly helps to increase carbon sequestration, water retention, and the population of beneficial microbes in soil. Compost must be spread in Sonoma County.

Pocket Park and McGinnis/Marsh Pathway

This project, expected to start this summer, includes improvements to Pocket Park at the end of La Salle Avenue (bollard lighting, benches, and bottle filling station), as well as repairing the pathways from McGinnis Circle to the Laguna bridge and to Marsh Way. The pathways will be decomposed granite, very similar to the new pathways on Richardson and West School Street.



2022 Street Maintenance Project

While the City works on reconstructing streets in poor condition, we need to continue to maintain our other streets to keep them in good condition. This will allow us to move to a much lower cost maintenance program in the future. The planned maintenance program this summer includes over 3 miles streets!

Kotate Park 2.0

After many public workshops, the updates to Kotate Park are expected to begin this summer! Planned improvements include all new playgrounds, adult fitness area, picnic areas, public restroom, and new landscaping and safety lighting.
