



Old Redwood Highway Gateway Project

This project is nearing completion and consists of the new pedestrian plazas at Old Redwood Highway at Highway 116, new sidewalks, trees and lighting along Old Redwood Highway and roadway paving an in-roadway lighted crosswalk at La Plaza and striping including crosswalks. Thank you for your patience with the lane closures during construction.

Old Redwood Highway South Rehabilitation Project

This project consists of repaving and striping through downtown, refurbishing crosswalks and accessibility ramps. An in-roadway lighted crosswalk has been installed with this project across Old Redwood Highway at Page Street. Final touches are being wrapped up and this project is essentially complete. Thank you to businesses and the public for your patience during the construction.



Other projects completed this summer



Work has been completed on the Falletti Pathway Project near City Hall, Sidewalk accessibility Upgrades at La Plaza, the Wilford Lane and Gravenstein Way neighborhood, and on West School Street, and the Highway 116 Landscaping Project which added trees and median landscaping at the US 101 over pass.
