

Cotati Hotel & Market Hall

On July 28th, the community was invited to attend an open house at City Hall, to view plans, ask questions and provide comments on this proposed development project. The 150-room hotel, located at the southwest corner of Old Redwood and Gravenstein Highways, is described as an extension of Cotati's living room where everyone is welcome. In addition to the hotel, there will be an open air plaza which will host a variety of local events such as pop up art shops and live music, as well as the Market Hall.

Lighting Project

This fall, the City will be installing new lighting in several key areas of town, including in La Plaza Park to join both sides of the downtown at night, improve safety, and allow for more types of events. The project will also add pathway lighting to the key pedestrian paths between McGinnis and Marsh, as well as McGinnis and Lincoln, which joins the downtown area to the residential area behind Oliver's. Finally, the project will improve lighting at the pedestrian tunnel that is a key connector between the east and west sides of Cotati. Look for this soon!

East Cotati Avenue Paving Project

Measure G funds continue to allow the City to bring in more infrastructure grants, including a \$675,000 Federal Grant to repave East Cotati Avenue from the railroad crossing east to the City limits at Sunflower Drive. This project is now in design and is planned to be constructed in 2019.

L-Section Paving

Measure G as well as Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (SB1) state funding are being used to repave large portions of Cotati's L-Section behind Oliver's. Work has begun and will be expected to extend through September and be completed in early October.



Laguna Sewer Bypass Pipeline Project: Hwy 116 at SR 101 and Redwood Drive

A major sewer pipeline project will be underway in mid-September and extend into the winter months. This project will address existing sewer capacity issues, allow for revitalization of our downtown area and add redundancy during disasters. Drivers are encouraged to use alternative routes to avoid this area as delays are expected. Work will be mainly M-F 8 am -5 pm with some night work. Look to Nixle and Facebook for current construction updates.
