

What: Every month seniors 60 and older can receive a robust grocery box filled with up to 25 pounds of a variety of shelf-stable items and fresh produce.

Where: With multiple locations where you can pick up your monthly box, we can find one close to you. Give us a call at (707) 523-7903 to find a site.

How: Bring a photo ID to your first pick up and you can sign up and receive your first box that same day. Income guidelines apply.

Lighting Project

The City has installed new lighting in several key areas of town, including in La Plaza Park to join both sides of the downtown at night, improve safety, and allow for more types of events. The project also added pathway lighting to the key pedestrian paths between McGinnis and Marsh, as well as McGinnis and Lincoln, which joins the downtown area to the residential area behind Oliver’s Market. The project also improves lighting at the East School Street pedestrian tunnel that is a key connector between the east and west sides of Cotati. Look for all of these to be fully operational soon!

East Cotati Avenue Paving Project

Measure G funds continue to allow the City to bring in more infrastructure grants, including a \$675,000 Federal Grant to repave East Cotati Avenue from the railroad crossing east to the City limits at Sunflower Drive. This project is in final design and is planned to be constructed in 2019.
