

City of Cotati Earns Financial Transparency Award!

The City of Cotati (City) was awarded a 2nd straight Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting and the corresponding Award of Financial Reporting Achievement by the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA). These awards are for the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2020.



The Certificate of Achievement is the highest form of recognition for governmental accounting and financial reporting. The City has also been awarded 3 awards for the financial summary document (Popular Annual Financial Report), and 3 awards for the annual budget document. Achieving all 3 awards in the same year has allowed the City to win the "Triple Crown" which was awarded to less

Alarm Registration

Reminder that homes and businesses with burglar alarms in the City of Cotati must register (or renew) them by January 28 for 2022. Business License Renewals

Do you have a business in the City of Cotati? Just a reminder that Annual Business License Renewal payments are due to the City by January 31, 2022. Please reach out to the Administrative Services Department at 707-665-3631 for more information.

Dog Licensing

All dogs four months of age or older needs to be licensed. A dog license is issued every year beginning January 1st and expired December 31st. A current rabies certificate is required for each dog.

The cost for the dog license is:

- \$20.00 for each dog if spayed/neutered
- \$35.00 for each dog if not spayed/neutered
- Adults 55 and older get one free dog license per household

West Side Street Project

The \$3.7M West Side Street Project is underway! As the weather permits, the contractor will reconstruct Condor Ct., Robin, John Roberts, West Cotati Avenue, West School Street, Clifford, and Richardson in addition to a new pedestrian pathway on West School Street between the East School Street Tunnel and West Sierra Avenue. The contractor recently completed repaving of Old Redwood Highway between Myrtle and Page.

This is the next project in the City Council’s continuing large investment in the City Road system to fix our roads and reduce long term maintenance costs – much more to come!

Wayfinding Sign Program

As the next phase of the “wayfinding” directional signage program, the City will be constructing kiosk type informational signage downtown and at major entrances to the Laguna de Santa Rosa bicycle and pedestrian pathway. Installation is expected in January 2022.
