

What is Measure G?
 It’s the local revenue measure that maintains the financial viability of our small town, improves our infrastructure and works for all Cotati residents, including:

- Maintenance of our streets, parks, and public buildings.
- Funds park and recreation programs.
- Funds our local police department, including :
 911 Emergency Dispatch
 Domestic Violence Response Services
 Preventing and investigating property crimes like thefts and burglaries

East Cotati Avenue Paving Project
 Measure G funds continue to allow the City to bring in more infrastructure grants, including a \$675,000 Federal Grant to repave East Cotati Avenue from the railroad crossing east to the City limits at Sunflower Drive. This project design is complete and is planned to be constructed in 2019.

2019 Paving Project
 The City is also finalizing plans to repave and restore portions of L-Section, East Cotati Avenue, and Old Redwood Highway this summer. This is the yearly paving program prioritized by the City Council which is part of the City’s 5 year road plan. This program will continue to use Measure G funds to preserve the good roads while systematically fixing the other roads in town. Look for more information on the 5 year road plan on the City website soon!
